The Prout School is excited to offer The Prout Inspire program. An Inspire student has a specific learning profile that prohibits them from following a traditional college preparatory program but allows them to thrive in our catholic community with a modified curriculum. Supported by caring, expert teachers and a dedicated group of peer mentors, the Inspire program allows for each of its selected students to participate as much as they are able in regular academic settings through modified inclusion. The Inspire student also benefits from participation to the highest appropriate level in our spiritual, athletic, artistic, and social experiences. Prout is a Catholic community that teaches that all children of God belong.

The Inspire program offers a concrete expression of that belief that benefits not only the selected students, but the teachers and peer mentors who learn better how to love others as Jesus would. These students are breaking down barriers and are going to select colleges such as Villanova V United College and gaining access and opportunities to explore new things, gain independence and prepare for their bright future.

The Prout Inspire Program is designed to prepare students for independent living and job preparation after high school. At successful completion of the program, Inspire students (and parents and guardians) will be given the choice of whether to receive an Inspire Program certificate or Prout Inspire Diploma. The diploma may be used for applying for a job, while the program certificate would allow the students the right to continue services under IDEA until age 21.
