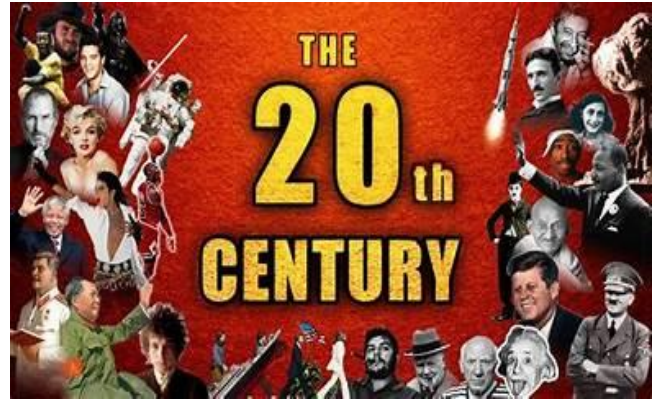


# IB World History HL 11 – Summer Assignment (2026)

**Activity 1 – Read Chapters 1,2 and 3 (20 points)** from the book, *A Short History of the 20<sup>th</sup> Century* by Geoffrey Blainey. Answer the questions for each chapter. Questions should be answered using complete sentences. Most require about 3-4 sentences for a complete response. If it says list, then you may create a list of items as your response.

**Activity 2 – Crash Course History – 3 Videos (20 points)**

Watch each video and complete the question sheet which accompanies each video. Question sheets and links for each video are on Google Classroom. Either print/download the question sheets or write out each question/answer on a separate sheet of paper.

**Activity 3 – US Imperialism – Document Based Questions (10 points)**

Read each document and answer questions using complete sentences. Either print/download the question sheets or write out each question/answer on a separate sheet of paper.

**Activity 4 – Beginning of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Interview (25 points)** – Interview a family member, relative or family friend who was at least 16 years old at the turn of the century. Interview questions are posted on Classroom. Answer the first few questions then pick 10 of the remaining and summarize the response for each.
